CODE OF ETHICS

As a member of the Schipperke Club of Canada, I agree to abide by the following Code of Ethics:

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP: Each member will:

- 1) Comply with the Schipperke Club of Canada Constitution and By-Laws, and its approved policies and procedures.
- 2) Do all in their power to protect and advance the best interests of the Schipperke breed of dog.
- 3) Provide their Schipperke(s) with a safe and healthy environment, appropriate housing, food, health care and training.
- 4) Practice good sportsmanship while participating in conformation, performance and other dog-related activities, doing nothing that might reflect negatively upon the Schipperke Club of Canada, or the Schipperke breed of dog in general.
- 5) Behave courteously at all times toward other Schipperke Club of Canada members, dog fanciers, and those interested in the Schipperke breed of dog.
- 6) Encourage any newcomers to the breed to join and/or participate in activities organized by the Schipperke Club of Canada.
- 7) Educate those interested in the Schipperke breed of dog, or the world of purebred dogs, regarding the merits and traits of the Schipperke breed of dog.

BREEDER MEMBERSHIP: The breeding of Schipperkes is a serious responsibility. Therefore, the decision to breed should never be taken lightly. To this end, every Schipperke Club of Canada Member Breeder will embrace the following principles:

- 1) Make a serious commitment of both time and financial resources in order to ensure that they carry out a proper and responsible breeding program
- 2) Work to preserve and maintain the Schipperke breed of dog for future generations through judicious selection of breeding stock.
- 3) Provide for the well-being of Schipperke(s) in their care, using suitable canine raising practices and health testing.
- 4) Fulfill the requirements of the Animal Pedigree Act (APA) of Canada, regarding the Registration of Schipperke litters and individual dogs.
- 5) Adhere at all times to proper and ethical business practices when buying, breeding, selling, and placing Schipperkes.

I am aware that failure to comply with this Code of Ethics could result in disciplinary action, such as denial of voting privileges, reprimand, revoking of Life Member status, suspension, or expulsion.
